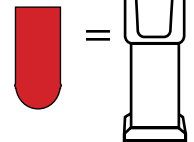

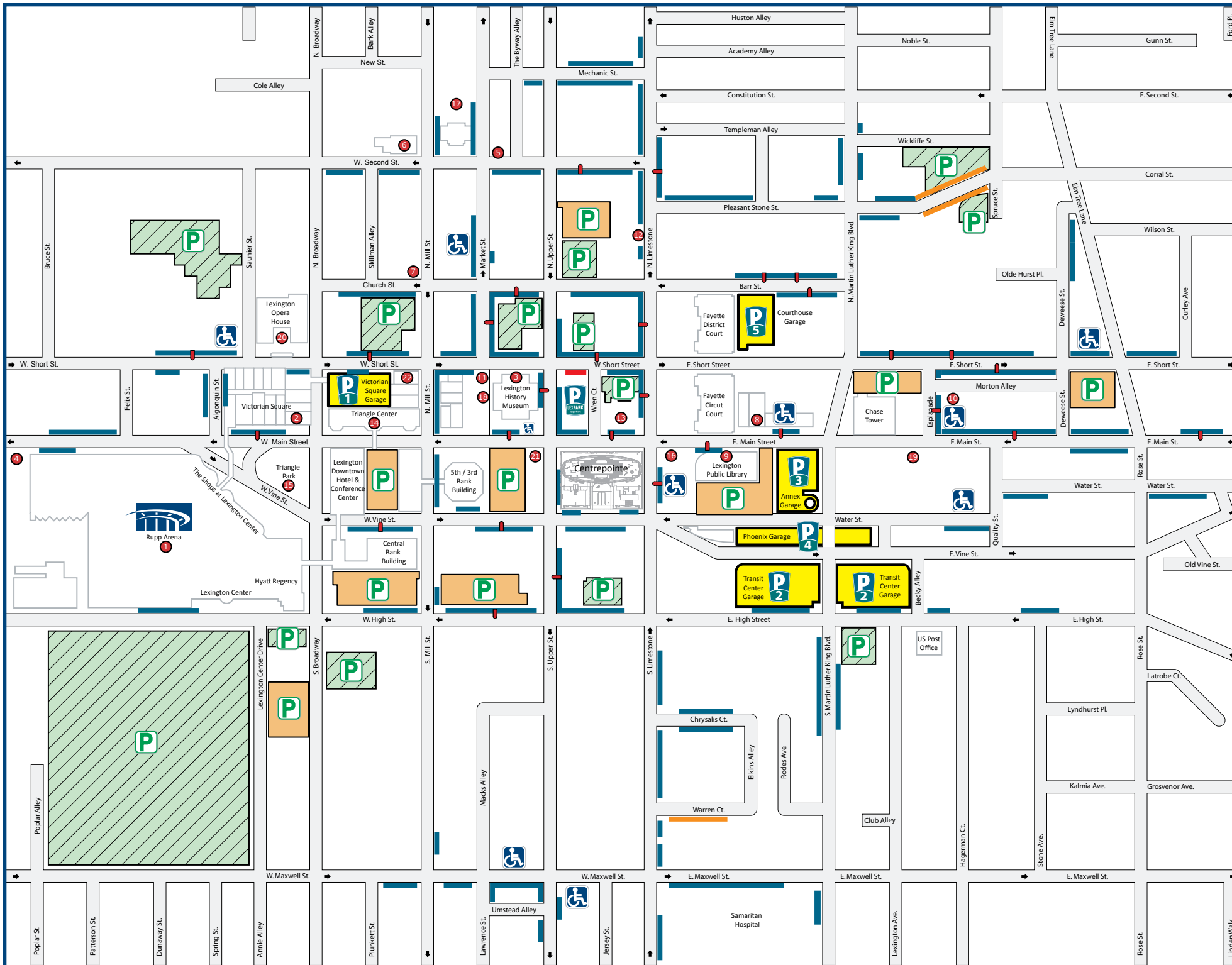

Meter Rates and Hours

The meters require \$.25 cents for 15 minutes, or \$1.00 for 1 hour in most areas. There are 1 hour, 2, hour and 4 hour meters strategically located throughout the area.

The meters are in effect from 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Parking at a meter after the time has expired is against the law. It's also against the law to extend your time at a meter beyond the time limit posted. It is called meter feeding, and it is illegal.

The Citation

Parking citations are issued by LEXPARK and the Lexington Police Department. Parking citations are \$15.00 and escalate to \$30.00 if not paid in 10 days.

Read the instructions on the citation about options for payment and appeal. To pay online, visit lexpark.org. You can mail in a check or pay by credit card at 114 N. Upper St. Lexington, KY 40507.

The Boot

Be sure to pay your citations promptly! Owners of vehicles who have three or more unpaid parking citations, may have their vehicle booted and even towed. The boot, a mechanical lock on the vehicle's wheel, can only be removed after all fines and penalties, plus a special booting penalty, are paid.

The Tow

If your vehicle has been towed because of a parking violation, call the Lexington Police Department at 258-3600.

You will be responsible for the towing fee.
